## Taboo



Players: 2-3 players

**Meterials:** deck of cards (It's okay if you don't have a full deck.)

Aces = 1, Jacks=10, Queens = 11, Kings = 12

(You are welcome to make these cards any value you want.)

**Objective:** to practice division as inverse operation of multiplication

## Instructions for 3 people:

- 1. Put the pile of cards between two people.
- 2. The two people each pick up a card without looking at it and hold it up to their forehead so the other person can see their card.
- 3. The third person calls out the product (multiplied answer) of the two cards.
- 4. The players holding up the card have to guess the card they have based on the product given and the card the other person is holding.

## Instructions for 2 people:

- 1. Put the pile of cards between the two players.
- 2. Each player picks up a card. The student player cannot look at their card and holds it up to their forehead.
- 3. The adult player puts down their card for the student to see and calls out the product when multiplying the student card with their own card.
- 4. The student player must guess the card they are holding to their forehead based on the product given and the value of the adult player's card.
